HOME CARE AIDES - Personal care and housekeeper aides to help you in your home; cost is income based.

LIFELINE (PERSONAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEM) -

A unit and personal help button in the home to call for help when an emergency arises. "Help needed" call rings at Emergency Response Center. Designated friends, relatives or neighbors are called to check on person.

OUTREACH VISITS - Visits to homebound, frail elderly to link to necessary community services.
